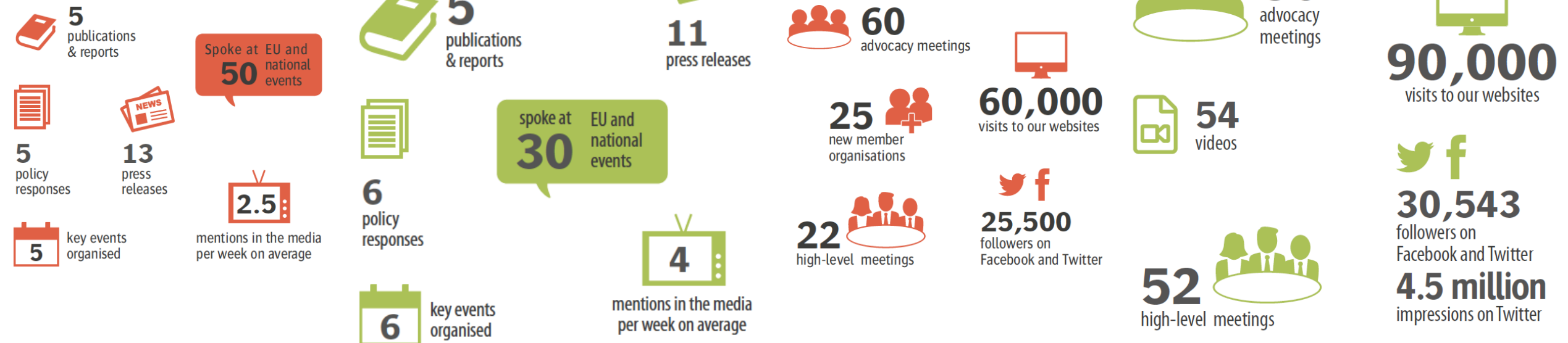

Safe and secure lives

- Update report on racist crime & institutional racism (2014-8)
- Report on data-driven policing & impact on racialised groups
- Research on impact of counter-terrorism measures on groups at risk of racism
- H2020 DARE – high-level advocacy and ethnographic research in prisons

Dismantling structural racism

- EP elections campaign (10 equality demands); renewed and more powerful **Anti-Racism & Diversity Intergroup**
- Supporting powerful NAPAR coalitions (BE/PT): **BE moves towards adoption of federal NAPAR**
- Islamophobia: **high-level statements**; start process for definition
- Antigypsyism: support to EU Roma Coalition; **EU moves towards more action on antigypsyism in renewed strategy**
- Afrophobia: **Landmark EP resolution**; learning module in Facing Facts
- Antisemitism: reach out to Jewish organisations



Dismantling structural racism

- ❑ EC publishes guidelines on equality data collection
- ❑ Equal@work: report on race and mental health at work; seminar on the racial impact of artificial intelligence in employment
- ❑ Roadmap to racial diversity in EU institutions
- ❑ Calls for anti-racist approach to migration
- ❑ Development (with CIJ) of a report on strategies to implement intersectional approaches in EU





Building a resilient network

- First draft of new network development strategy
- 2 training sessions: NAPAR; Human Rights Defenders (32 MOs)
- 12 national projects (see report)
- 2 anti-racist weeks in EP (capacity building, advocacy, GP exchanges)
- Improved communication and digital footprint (54 videos, 211 mentions in media, 50% increase of visits on website, 4.5m twitter impressions)
