CALL FOR APPLICATIONS ENAR NETWORK COVID-19 RECOVERY & RESILIENCE SCHEME 2020

ENAR is launching a new call to support its members' recovery and resilience in the context of the COVID-19 crisis.

WHY THIS CALL?

ENAR's work shows how COVID-19 is exacerbating and shining a light on existing structural racism.¹ In this context, ENAR member organisations and the communities they are working with have been facing many challenges. For the purpose of supporting the recovery and resilience of the network, ENAR has pooled extra resources (donations and part of its funding) to be able launch this call.

Objectives of this scheme :

- **Supporting the recovery** of the member organisations by addressing immediate material needs related to remote working and organising, technical equipment, access to digital platforms, activities to support the communities they work with, fixed costs of the organisations and volunteers etc.
- **Supporting the resilience** of the member organisations by catering for capacity building, coaching, and psychosocial support for the anti-racist organisers/activists

WHO CAN APPLY?


ENAR member organisations which have paid their 2020 membership fee and have **less than €20,000 yearly income** are eligible for this scheme.

Applications from members who have an operations budget between €20,000 and €50,000 can be exceptionally considered, subject to availability of funds and how essential their applications to their sustainability.

The applicant organisations need to have a bank account.

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HOW TO APPLY?

Applications should be sent via email to Myriam De Feyter at myriam@enar-eu.org. In the subject, the applications must be marked “ENAR COVID Recovery and Resilience - 2020 – name of applying member organisation” by **September 4, 2020**.

Applications can be sent in one of the following two application formats:

- 1) **Template:** You can fill in the annexed template and attach it to your email (max 2 pages).
- 2) **Video:** You can send us a link to a video of yourself/your team in your email answering the same questions in the annexed template. The video must be downloadable and maximum 10 min long.

The proposals should be in line with the objectives of this call. A simple budget indicating the estimated costs should be included in the application.

COMPENSATION

The applications for small grants aim to respond to the specific needs of member organisations as they specify them. The applicants can request the compensation amount based on these needs for up to **€5000 (Five thousand Euros)** per organisation. This amount includes all administrative costs and taxes, including VAT, when applicable. The payment will be done in two installments: once the contract is signed (80%) and the second following approval by ENAR of the final report (20%).

GUIDELINES and TIMELINE

Selected applicants are expected to:

- 1) Implement the proposal till **June 15, 2021**.
- 2) Respond within a reasonable time to ENAR’s communications, consultations and enquiries during the implementation.
- 3) Provide ENAR with a final report by **June 30, 2021** (max 1 page). The reporting template will be provided by ENAR.
